Primary Photo ID - must be valid and/or current year

Driver's Licence (issued by Canadian province or territory)

Foreign Driver's Licence

Canadian Passport

Foreign Passport

Canadian Citizenship Card

Permanent Resident Card (PR)

Status Card

Student Identity card from a foreign institute

Firearms Acquisition Certificate (FAC)

Canadian National Institute of the Blind (CNIB) identification card

Federal, Provincial, or Municipal identification card

Military Family identification card (MFID)

Nexus card

Student ID card (current year)

Health Card (with photo) *if presented by the applicant - we cannot ask for it or record the number

If you do not have one of the required primary photo ID, the following may be accepted:
